JoJo arrived at Pasadena Humane after a terrible accident. When this sweet kitten was found as a stray, it was clear that she had experienced a horrible injury. Her ear was torn and bleeding, causing the poor girl an unfathomable amount of pain. We didn't know how she ended up so tragically injured, but we knew that she desperately needed our help.

She was rushed into surgery, where we carefully cleaned her wounds and stitched up her injured ear, allowing her to heal without complications. A YOUNG OPOSSUM THRIVES

How Your Support Gives Injured Wildlife a Second Chance

At our Sandra J. Goodspeed Wildlife Center, we care for orphaned and injured wild animals with the goal of returning them to the wild. So, when a young opossum with a crooked wrist came into our care, we knew that her ability to thrive would depend on if she could walk and climb like any other healthy opossum. But her crooked wrist heavily impacted her mobility, and with every step she took, she would roll her front paw. After an x-ray didn't show any fractures or other obvious injuries, our wildlife team splinted her front foot in the hopes that it could help straighten out her wrist – and sure enough, it worked!

With her wrist straight and her splint removed, the young opossum began physical therapy to strengthen her muscles. Our wildlife team also taught her how to forage (a very important opossum skill) by hiding food in different areas of her multi-level enclosure. **Thanks to you, we are able to give injured wildlife like this opossum the specialized care they need to return to their wild homes.**

You helped save this sweet husky from a life-threatening infection

When Coffee Bean arrived at Pasadena Humane, it quickly became clear that something was wrong. The poor dog was having difficulty breathing. She was coughing nonstop, and our veterinary team feared she had an infection in her lungs. She was tired and stressed, working hard to take each breath of air.

Because of caring people like you, we were able to respond quickly, rushing Coffee Bean into the exam room. Radiographs revealed that her lungs and airways were painfully thickened. Unfortunately, Coffee Bean showed no response to the initial rounds of treatment that we provided for her. Determined to save this sweet girl's life, we contacted a specialist who performed a CT scan and biopsy in hopes of finding her a cure.

Our team worked tirelessly to help Coffee Bean. After multiple studies, the specialist confirmed that Coffee Bean suffered from a rare lower airway infection that most commonly affects huskies. **Thanks to the support of animal lovers like you, we were able to get her the vital care and medications that she needed, allowing her to breathe comfortably once more.**

With the lifesaving resources that you've provided, Coffee Bean got the chance to begin her life anew. **It is because of your support that we are able to give animals like Coffee Bean the second chance that they deserve.**
