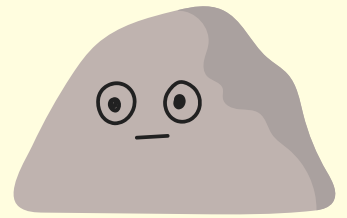


PET ROCK ADOPTION GUIDE
